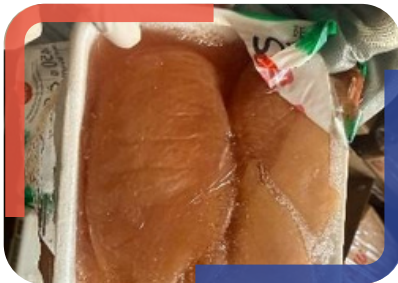
Cargo Damage / Missing Survey – Assorted Perfumery Products

A survey was conducted to assess the alleged damage reported to the consignment of assorted perfumery products. The inspection included verification of cargo condition, extent of damage (if any), and documentation to support findings and facilitate further evaluation.



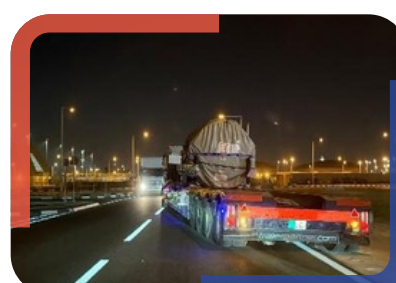
Flight Engine Import

Discharge monitoring was conducted for the nominated cargo — one Engine shipped in three packages, including the Fan Case with Stand, Storage Kit, and Engine Core with Stand. The cargo was safely discharged at Hamad International Airport, Qatar, with all operations carried out under strict handling protocols and safety standards.



Cargo Damage–Frozen Chicken Consignment

A condition survey was carried out on the containerized consignment of frozen chicken half breasts (boneless, skinless) following a reported cargo damage incident. The inspection focused on assessing cargo condition, documenting observations, and supporting the evaluation process.



Engine Road Movement

The operation required detailed route surveys, load calculations, and coordination with to ensure safe transit. Escorts and traffic management were arranged to handle oversized cargo and minimize disruption. Strict safety measures were followed throughout the movement to prevent damage to the engine and surrounding infrastructure.



Loading & Lashing Inspection

Loading and lashing inspection was carried out for 12 packages comprising two helicopter components and associated accessories, secured on 2 x 40' flat rack containers. The inspection ensured correct cargo positioning, proper securing arrangements, and adequate lashing integrity in compliance

with safe transport and cargo securing standards prior to shipment.



Flight Engine Export

Load monitoring was performed for the nominated cargo, one Engine shipped in three packages. The operation encompassed safe loading at Hamad International Airport for its voyage. The scope included supervision of cargo handling and securing processes, strict adherence

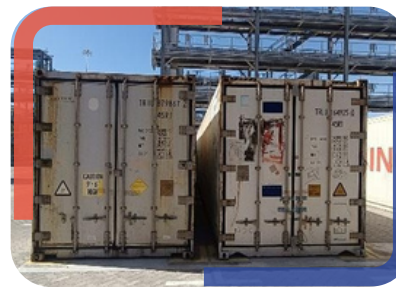
to safety and handling standards, and reporting of any damage or incidents observed during the operation.

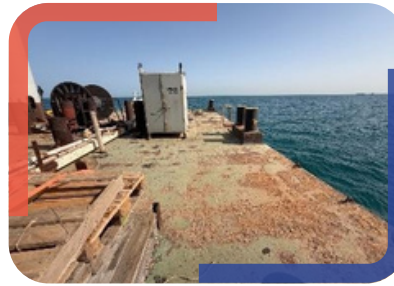

On Hire Bunker Survey

On-hire bunker refers to the quantity of fuel oil, or other consumables remaining on board a vessel at the time it is delivered back to owners at the end of a time charter. During an on-hire survey, the bunker quantities are carefully measured to establish the exact amount onboard. This ensures accurate reconciliation

between owners and charterers for fuel consumption and cost settlements. Our team provides professional off-hire bunker surveys, including precise tank soundings, calculations, and reporting, to safeguard the interests of both owners and charterers and ensure transparency in the handover process.



Towage Inspection

Towage operations of tugs and barges were successfully executed under strict safety protocols and precise operational coordination. Comprehensive inspections were conducted to ensure the reliability and efficiency of the towage, including verification of towing equipment such as lines, winches, and hooks. The condition of

the tugs and barges was thoroughly assessed to identify any wear or damage, ensuring optimal performance and safety throughout the operation.

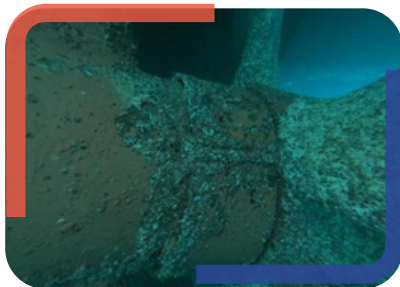

HFO Tank Cleaning & NDT (DPT) for Leak Protection

HFO tank cleaning was carried out to remove sludge, residues, and contaminants, followed by Non-Destructive Testing using Dye Penetrant Testing (DPT). The inspection was conducted to identify surface defects, verify weld integrity, and ensure effective

leak prevention and structural soundness of the tank.



Underwater Diving Services

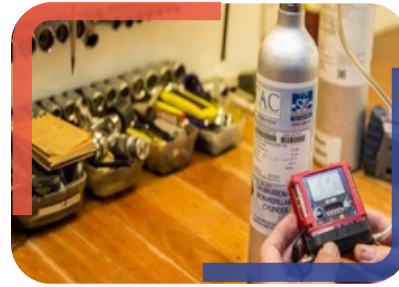

Calibration of Dew Point Meter

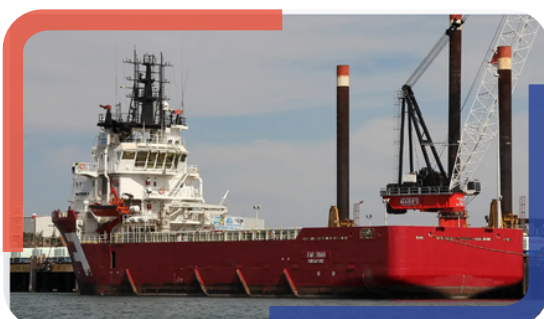
The team carried out the calibration of a dew point meter, performing accuracy checks and adjustments before delivering it back to the client for continued operational use.
